Maria M. Love - ma RYE yah - 1840 - 1931.

Born in Clarence, NY on January 26, 1840, and raised in Buffalo, Maria was a true social services pioneer who founded the first daycare in America, and the first kindergarten in Buffalo!

"Maria" founded the Maria M. Love Convalescent Fund in 1903 when the needs in the community grew too great for her personal charity alone.
